

The Everett Clinic Residency Program

Purpose/Mission

To train and retain well prepared Nurse Practitioners & PA-C's who will continue to provide patient care in primary care, multi-specialty and hospital settings.

The residency is a one year program designed to provide additional support to newly graduated ARNPs & PA-C's as they transition from new practitioner to independent provider in a variety of care settings.

Program Goals

- To ensure high quality ARNPs & PA-C's who are prepared to function as providers in today's changing health care environment.
- To equip newly graduated ARNPs & PA-C's with the skills needed to confidently provide care.
- To provide a supportive environment to increase newly graduated ARNPs & PA-C's confidence when working in a variety of care settings.
- After successfully completing the residency program, residents will be eligible to apply for openings at The Everett Clinic.

Program Curriculum

Precepted continuity clinical rotations	4 days per week	In precepted clinic the residents are partnered with an Everett Clinic provider (ARNP or MD/DO) who is available for consultation. 2 days precepted by an ARNP / 2 day precepted by MD/DO.
Daily huddle	30 minutes daily	Dedicated time each morning to discuss complex, complicated cases with assigned preceptor.
Specialty rotations	half day sessions per week	Formal learning sessions on a variety of high risk/high volume health problems. Rotations may include: allergy, rheumatology, behavioral health, cardiology, dermatology, diabetes/endocrinology, ENT, gastroenterology, hospitalist, nephrology, neurology, nephrology, gynecology, orthopedics, pediatrics, podiatry, pulmonary, radiology and urology.
Didactic education	45 minutes, 3 times a week	Formal learning sessions that orderly and methodically review and further explore complex clinical challenges, allowing the resident to delve deeper into complex health issues.
