### **Funding Guidelines**

#### **Introduction**

The Everett Clinic Foundation is a non-profit corporation established by The Everett Clinic physicians and staff to provide philanthropic support to charitable organizations in Snohomish County. A Board of Directors, which is responsible for all giving decisions, administers the Foundation.

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

The Foundation can consider grants to organizations that are classified by the Internal Revenue Service as 501©(3) programs.

Grant requests must identify what the benefit is to Snohomish County residents. Preference is given to programs that involve direct human services, such as family services, youth programs, emergency food and shelter, and healthcare. Limited funding is available for capital campaigns. Typical grants range from \$500 to \$20,000. We receive requests far in excess of our funding resources, and unfortunately, we need to turn down many worthy requests.

The Foundation does not fund the following: individual grants, fellowships and scholarships; religious causes; political candidates or issues; or organizations outside of our local region.

Organizations may submit one application per year. If an agency has multiple programs, only one per year will be considered. Requests from schools need to come through the School District Foundation rather than from individual schools.
